Semi finalists set for PFL Playoffs

The final day of the regular 2010/2011 CUC Primary Football League (PFL) Playoffs took place this past Saturday, January 22 at the Annex Field with the chance to play in the semi finals on the line for a majority of teams.

In the Under-9 Champions Cup, George Town Primary joined defending champions St. Ignatius Prep, Cayman Prep and Sir John A. Cumber Primary in the semi finals following their 5-1 demolition of Triple C. In other games Cayman Prep won their fourth Playoff game in a row defeating St. Ignatius Prep 3-1, Sir John A. Cumber defeated NorthEast Schools 1-0 and Bodden Town Primary and South Sound Schools battled to a 2-2 draw. In the semi finals this Saturday, January 29, top-seeded Cayman Prep will face George Town Primary and Sir John A. Cumber will go up against St. Ignatius Prep.

In the Under-9 Consolation Cup, Cayman International School secured a spot in the semi finals with a 4-0 win over Wesleyan Academy. In other games, Grace Academy defeated Savannah Primary 3-2 and Red Bay Primary continued their winning ways with a 3-0 victory over Truth For Youth. Top-seeded Red Bay Primary will play Cayman International School and Prospect Primary face Grace Academy in the semi finals.

In the Under-11 Champions Cup, the outcome from a postponed game between George Town Primary and Cayman Prep scheduled for Wednesday, January 26, will determine the final two schools joining defending champions St. Ignatius Prep and Prospect Primary in the semi finals. In games played this past Saturday, Prospect Primary squeezed by Sir John A. Cumber Primary 1-0, St. Ignatius Prep defeated NorthEast Schools 1-0 and Red Bay Primary was 4-0 victors over Bodden Town Primary.

In the Under-11 Consolation Cup, Savannah Primary clinched the fourth and final place in the semi finals with a heart-stopping 2-1 victory over South Sound Schools. Savannah Primary joins
