PFL Playoffs resume with a New Year's bang

The playoffs for the 2010/2011 CUC Primary Football League (PFL) resumed this past Saturday, January 8 at the Annex Field with thirteen action-packed games.

In the Under-9 Champions Cup, defending champions St. Ignatius Prep squandered a two-goal lead and suffered their first loss of the 2010/2011 season going down 2-3 to a spirited Triple C outfit. Cayman Prep and Sir John A. Cumber Primary continued their winning ways with a resounding 5-0 win over George Town Primary and a 2-0 victory over South Sound Schools respectively.

In the Under-9 Consolation Cup, defending champions Truth For Youth were held to a 1-1 draw by Wesleyan Academy, while Prospect Primary defeated Cayman International School 2-1 and Red Bay Primary recorded a 4-0 victory over Savannah Primary.

In the Under-11 Champions Cup, defending champions St. Ignatius Prep bounced back from a 2-2 draw with Cayman Prep on the opening day of the playoffs in December by beating Prospect Primary 3-1. NorthEast Schools recorded their first win in the playoffs overcoming George Town Primary 2-1, while Bodden Town Primary fought back to draw with Cayman Prep 2-2. In what surely was the match of the day, Red Bay Primary outlasted Sir John A. Cumber Primary on their way to a solid 3-1 victory.

Finally, in the Under-11 Consolation Cup, Cayman International School defeated South Sound Schools 4-0, Truth For Youth were 3-1 winners over Triple C and Savannah Primary were winners over Wesleyan Academy by the score of 4-0.

The third day of the 2010/2011 PFL Playoffs is scheduled for this Saturday, January 15 at the Annex Field with games from 9:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m.
