### PFL Semi Finals Complete

During an action-packed day of exciting youth football, eight finalists confirmed their places in the respective 2010/2011 CUC Primary Football League cup competitions this past Saturday, January 29 at the hallowed Annex Field in George Town. The four finals and two third place games are scheduled for this coming Saturday, February 5.

In the Under-9 Champions Cup, defending champions St. Ignatius Prep will defend their title against local foes Cayman Prep after narrowly overcoming a lively Sir John A. Cumber Primary outfit 3-2. Cayman Prep ran out 6-0 winners over George Town Primary in the other semi final. Sir John A. Cumber will face George Town Primary in the third place game, which will precede the final.

In the Under-9 Consolation Cup, Red Bay Primary will play Grace Academy in the final following their 6-0 victory over a very young Cayman International School. In the other semi final, Grace Academy defeated Prospect Primary 2-1.

In the Under-11 Champions Cup, defending champions St. Ignatius Prep will square-off against Prospect Primary for the coveted title. St. Ignatius Prep was stretched to the limit by a determined George Town Primary team, following a 0-0 full time and extra time score. In the deciding penalty shootout, St. Ignatius Prep finally triumphed 4-3 in sudden death after both teams missed a penalty apiece. In the other semi final, Prospect Primary overcame a 1-0 half time deficit to win 2-1 against rivals Red Bay Primary and book their place in the final. In the third-place game, George Town Primary will face Red Bay Primary.

In the Under-11 Consolation Cup, Truth For Youth defeated Savannah Primary 4-1 to face Cayman International School in the final. Cayman International School overcame South Sound Schools 4-0 in their semi final.
