This position is temporary in nature as it relates to filling a much-needed position until an employee returns from medical leave.

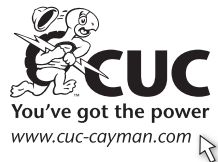
The successful candidate will be responsible for performing general building maintenance for all CUC buildings including:

- » carpentry work such as fabricating furniture, shipping containers, building repairs, shelving, doors and drywall work;
- » plumbing work such as repairing and replacing leaking pipes, maintenance of washrooms, bathrooms and septic systems;
- » masonry work such as laying of concrete blocks, pouring of concrete for small projects, constructing small foundations, masonry patching and repairing;
- » steel work such as erecting lightweight steel and repairing building sheeting;
- » pipe work such as erecting/repairing PVC and fibreglass pipe systems;
- » general maintenance such as replacing windows, painting, tiling and moving office furniture.

Applicants must possess a high school diploma with formal training in building construction or equivalent training and experience with a minimum of eight (8) years related work experience in Facilities Maintenance. Supervisory experience is required as well as a proficiency in MicroSoft Office and HTE computer software.

Salary is between \$3,150 and \$4,725 per month.
