Warning Tampering with Meters is Illegal



CUC reminds the public that its electricity meters installed on customers' premises are protected by law. It is unlawful to dishonestly waste or divert any electricity, or to destroy any meter. Accordingly, in any instance where a meter has been found to have been unlawfully removed, disconnected, shorted-out, damaged or tampered with in any way, or where the meter seals have been broken, the supply of electricity will be immediately disconnected and CUC will require payment of a connection fee of up to \$500.00 as well as payment in full for any electricity illegally obtained before service can be restored. In addition, any person who has committed a criminal offence in relation to an electricity meter will be liable to prosecution and may on conviction be penalised by imprisonment, a fine or both.

Only authorised CUC employees are permitted to install, remove or otherwise work on the Company's electricity meters.
