Tree Trimming near Power Lines



Never attempt to prune or trim trees that grow within 10 feet of power lines. Only qualified personnel approved by CUC should trim trees or branches within 10 feet of power lines. Contact with a high voltage power line can result in serious injury or even death.

Always ensure that trees and branches on your property are properly maintained and grow away from power lines. Trees or branches that grow over 10 feet away from power lines can be trimmed by landscapers.

Our tree trimming is aimed at keeping over 450 miles of transmission and distribution lines clear of trees and undergrowth. Through our focus on effective vegetation management, which includes periodic inspections of power lines and information from customers, we can identify trees that are growing too close to power lines and thus, cause concern for public safety and reliability.
