- Rules:**
1. Because there are two schools from Group A and three schools from Group B, points from games played against schools in the same Group during the regular season that have advanced to the Under 9 Consolation Cup will be brought forward to the Playoffs..
  2. Games are 40 minutes (4 quarters of 10 minutes with a 2 minute water break between quarters) with a win worth 3 points, a draw worth 1 point and no points for a loss.
  3. Top four schools with the most points advance to the Semi Finals (goal difference will be deciding factor to determine final standings if schools are tied on points. If goal difference is the same between schools, the "head-to-head" result will determine final standings).
  4. In the Semi Finals, 1 plays 4 and 2 plays 3 (drawn randomly if schools are tied on points and goal difference).
  5. Two Semi Final winners play in the Finals. There is no third-place in the Consolation Cup.
  6. If the two schools are level after fulltime in the Semi Finals and Final, there will be 10 minutes of overtime (5 minutes each way) followed by penalties (best of 3 then sudden death) to decide a winner.
